


New underground pipes coming in 2023

These new pipes will connect Wallingford's existing combined sewer outfall pipe to the future storage tunnel. This work began in January 2023 and is expected to be complete by late 2024.

Parking restrictions


along N 34th St, N 35th St, Stone Way N and Woodland Park Ave N

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) and King County Wastewater Treatment Division are building an underground storage tunnel to significantly reduce the amount of polluted stormwater and sewage that flows into the Lake Washington Ship Canal, Salmon Bay, and Lake Union from our sewer system.
